AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM

MCTV is participating in the federal government's Affordable Connectivity Program. The program aims to increase access to broadband Internet service by providing a discount of up to \$30/month towards Internet service for eligible households.

Households are eligible by meeting one of these criteria:

- Household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines; or
- You, your child or dependent, participates in one of the following assistance programs:
 - Lifeline
 - SNAP (food stamps)
 - Medicaid
 - Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC)
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Federal Public Housing Assistance
 - Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefits
 - Free and Reduced-Price School Lunch Program or School Breakfast Program, including at USDA Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) schools or Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year

The benefit is limited to one monthly Internet discount/household and is non-transferrable. If the program ends, or if a household is no longer eligible, customers will be subject to MCTV's regular rates, terms and conditions.
